

Organic Services Events

General Terms and Conditions

1. Applicability

The following general terms and conditions are valid for all Organic Services events. All services

provided in the context of the event will be subject to these General Terms and Conditions. By registering, you are agreeing to these GTC. Apart from these, the provisions of the Civil Code (BGB) apply.

2. Registration

After having registered for the meeting, a confirmation will be sent.

3. Cancellation

(1) Cancellations shall be in writing and sent by post or email.

(2) In case of cancellation

- a. more than 20 days prior to the start of the event, cancellation is free of charge.
- b. 5 days prior to the start of the meeting, an administration fee of Euro 50.- will be charged.
- c. Less than 5 days before the event the full fee will be charged.

4. Designation of a substitute

Designation of a substitute is possible but shall be notified prior to the start of the event.

5. Changes to the programme, place or timing of the event

- a. With good reason, the organiser is entitled to change place and/or date of the event. Registrations may be cancelled within 10 days after being notified.
- b. With good reason, the event may be cancelled; any paid charges will be refunded. No claims for compensation above and beyond refund are eligible.
- c. The organiser may cancel the event up to 14 days before its start without reason.
- d. In case of force majeure, for example war, unrest, natural disaster, fire, strike, lock-out, sabotage by third parties, official order, etc. neither party may hold the other liable for any delay to or non-performance of the agreement which results from this force majeure.
- e. The organiser reserves the right to make changes to the programme.

6. Payment and services

Payment is due for all services as listed in the announcement of the applicable event. No compensation will be made for any single or part of the services.

7. Liability

Regardless of the legal reason, the organisers are only liable for financial and material damage arising intentionally or from gross negligence. The organisers accept no liability for: accidents occurring during the meeting, or during travel to or from the meeting venue, theft, or loss of or damage to any items.

8. Data protection

All personal data are kept confidential. All data necessary for administrative purposes will be stored in compliance with relevant laws. Where appropriate, relevant data will be passed on to associated and/or third parties assigned with specific tasks.

9. Applicable law and jurisdiction

- a. The provisions of the Civil Code (BGB) shall apply.
- b. The place of jurisdiction for all claims relating to the event is Munich, Germany.
- c. Should any provision of these GTC be or become ineffective, the effectiveness of all other provisions will stay valid.
